### **1. Business Quiz 11:00 am – 12:00noon**

**Venue: Room No. 102 (JIMS Building)**

#### **Rules and Regulations:**

- Members per team should be 3.
- Only team entries will be considered.
- All the students of a particular team should be from the same institute / college or university.
- Replacement of participants will not be considered after registration.
- There can be an elimination round or qualifying rounds if the judges or quizmaster jointly decide on the spot.
- The decision of quiz master and judges will be final and binding.
- Team(s) can be disqualified if it is found that unfair means have been adopted or if there is any case of indiscipline.

**Rules and Regulations:**

- No team restrictions on teams registering per Institute.

- Each team will be given 3 minutes to speak on the topic.
- Debate should be in English only.
- Each team will be given 1 minute to think about the topic before starting the debate.
- Debaters should conduct themselves with dignity and be courteous towards other debaters and officials.
- Decision of judges will be final and binding.

#### **7. Bollywood Quiz 10:30am-11:30 am** **Venue: Room no. 102 (JIMS Building)**

##### **Rules and Regulations:**

- Each team will comprise of 2 members
- There may be an elimination or qualifying round if the organizer and judges feel that number of teams have exceeded the expected number
- Decision of judges will be final and binding on teams
- Team(s) can be disqualified if it is found that unfair means have been adopted or if there is any case of indiscipline

- All the participants in a particular team should be from the same institute, college, university.
- The decision of the judge will be final and binding on the participants and no clarification or question will be entertained in this regard.

**10. Business Plan 01:45pm – 02:45 pm**

**Venue: Room No. 101 (JIMS Building)**

**Rules and Regulations:**

- There should not be more than 3 members in a team.
- Proposed Business should not exceed a start-up capital of Rs 10,00,000/- (rupees ten lac)
- All teams have to come prepared with power-point presentations
- All teams must carry two copies of handouts (paper print) of their presentation
- Time limit:
  - 7 minutes for presentation and;
  - 3 minutes for question-answer round
- Business Plan should consist of the following:
  - Executive summary
  - About the company
  - Product / Service details
  - Market analysis
  - Financial plan
  - Strategy and implementation
- The teams will be judged on following criteria:

- Innovative idea
- Business model (how it will work, revenue, profits)
- Probability of success
- Resource allocation and management
- Competitive advantage
- Marketing plan
- Disclosure of threats (existing and probable) to business
- Decision of judges will be final and binding in all respects
